All competitors who forward completed Entry Forms agree to be bound by the rules. Final Instructions form an integral part of the Supplementary Regulations.

Class 11	Modified cars 1451cc to 1650cc, 2 Wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder.
Class 12	Modified cars 1651cc to 2100cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
Class 13	Modified cars 1651cc to 2100cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder.
Class 14	Modified cars 2101cc to 3500cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated or turbo charged.
Class 15	Four Wheel Drive cars whose homologation has expired and other specified cars. Appendix '29' current yearbook.
Class 16	Cars up to 1650cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated. Drivers to be under 26 on 1 st January 2011 and contested over a limited number of stages.

at Standard Rate, and personal Accident Insurance. All Licence
Holders must produce an IRDS or BRDS letter of acceptance before
they can commence the event.

As the event is limited to a starting number of 141 plus 20 Juniors,
only fully completed entry forms, which are accompanied by the entry
fee, will be accepted. Unless the 'recent results' section is fully
completed, re-seeding requests will not be accepted.

Entries will be accepted by post only. Postal entries will be registered
at time of delivery on 7th March. Entries received before 7th will be
held until all valid entries received on the opening date have been
registered.

The onus rests competitors to ensure that adequate funds are available
to ensure uninterrupted processing of entry fee cheque i.e. returned
unpaid cheques will invalidate entry.

(a) I have read the supplementary regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of MI including the guidelines and regulations contained in Motorsport Ireland's Code of Conduct for Children's Sport. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the CMMC Ltd, Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
