These regulations have been submitted to and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for the holding of the competition has been granted, **permit no. 13/058**. The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and these Supplementary Regulations including Appendix 25, 29 & 31 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook. All competitors who forward completed entry forms agree to be bound by the rules. Final Instructions form an integral part of the Supplementary Regulations.

If 5 or more entries are not received in each class the organisers reserves the right to amalgamate classes or reduce awards accordingly. Competitors affected will be notified and may withdraw.

**CLASSES:** The event will include the following classes as defined in Appendix 29, MI Yearbook 2013:

- Class 1 Gp N up to 1400cc
- Class 2 Gp N 1401cc to 1600cc
- Class 3 Gp N 1601cc to 2000cc
- Class 4 Gp N over 2000cc
- Class 5 Gp A up to 1400cc
- Class 6 Gp A 1401cc to 1600cc
- Class 7 Gp A 1601cc to 2000cc
- Class 8 Gp A over 2000cc
- Class 9 Modified cars up to 1450cc, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 10 Modified cars 1451cc to 1650cc, not more than 2 valves per cylinder, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 11 Modified cars 1451cc to 1650cc, more than 2 valves per cylinder, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 12 Modified cars 1651cc to 2100cc, not more than 2 valves per cylinder, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 13 Modified cars 1651cc to 2100cc, more than 2 valves per cylinder, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 14 Modified cars 2101cc to 3500cc, 2 wheel drive.
- Class 15 Four Wheel Drive cars whose homologation has expired. See Notes 3 & 5.
- Class 16 Juniors. Junior Class for Licence holders under 26 years of age on 01-01-13 driving a car up to 1650cc. NOTE: Juniors will compete on the first six stages of the event subject to the number of starters in the main field. Otherwise, they will compete from Stage 4.
- Class 18 Historics. Historic cars up to 1981 as per Appendix 29 Articles 17-21. Historics will compete on the first six stages of the event.
- Class 20 Four Wheel Drive (4WD) Cars. 4WD (forced induction or normally aspirated) cars modified to an extent not permitted for homologated versions; non homologated 4WD production cars; and cars authorised for use at the discretion of Motorsport Ireland under Appendix 29, Category 2. See Note 16.

**NO CASH PLEASE**

The entry fee is €495 / £420stg, Historics & Juniors €250 / £215stg, including IRDS at Standard Rate, and Personal Accident Insurance. All licence holders must produce an IRDS or BRDS letter of acceptance before they can commence the event.

As the event is limited to a starting number of 141, only fully completed entry forms, which are accompanied by the entry fee, will be accepted. Unless the "recent results" section is fully completed, re-seeding requests will not be accepted.

Entries will be accepted by post only.

The onus rests with competitors to ensure that adequate funds are available to ensure uninterrupted processing of entry fee cheque i.e. returned unpaid cheques will invalidate entry.

(a) I have read the supplementary regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of MI including the guidelines and regulations contained in Motorsport Ireland’s Code of Conduct for Children’s Sport. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the CMMC Ltd, Irish Automobile Club Ltd t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contribute to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
