Collecting your information

Competitors - We collect your information when you fill in a competition event entry form. You can give us your information using paper or online forms. The information you give us may include your contact details (name, address, telephone number, email address), personal information and identifiers (date of birth, competition licence number, driving licence number, and other information (vehicle details). When you give us information about another person, such as a child, parent, guardian, or emergency contact you should let that person know that you have given us the information.

If you are under 18 years old, we will also ask for information from your parent or guardian.

Using your information

Competitors - We will use your information when you enter our events. For competitions, we will publish some of your information in the programme and the results, which will be in the public domain. Your information is used in these ways to fulfil our contract with you.

We may ask you for emergency contact and next of kin details which we will only use in an emergency, and which is use for a legitimate interest. You should let the contact and next of kin know that you have given this information to us.

We will not sell your information to another organisation.

Marshals – We will use your information to contact about our events.

We will not sell your information to another organisation.

We may keep your information indefinitely, unless you ask us to delete it.

Sharing your information

Competitors - We may share your information with the Motorsport Ireland / RIAC / FIA as required by its General Regulations for governing motor sport, with other MI Registered Clubs, with medical personnel, or any other person if we have to comply with a legal obligation. We may also share your information with service providers, for example the online entry system or to include in the event programme.

Marshals – We will not share your information with any other organisation other than MI appointed motorsport event officials/ Motorsport Ireland.
